And the end result? YES some fabulous nail art was achieved, YES everyone learnt something, Whether by collaborating, teaching or creating and YES everyone wanted to do and learn more.

donate amazing prizes, not only for winners in the respective categories, but also often second and third place getters. Some of the categories are created on the day, but other categories are hand in so can be done in advance, so the chances of getting a prize or multiple mean it can certainly be well worthwhile! A couple of medals added to your own wall of fame along with your certificates is also good for business and your clients love to know their nail technician is an award winning one!

How do you get started? Firstly have a look at the different websites (listed below). Check out the different categories that you can enter within and see some of the work that has been done by other nail artists as well as the rules for each of the categories. Remember the nail art in competitions does not have to last as it would on a client and dependent on the category, you can often let the imagination go wild! To get started, I like to give my students a picture that they can use. Often a picture is pleasing to the eye as it draws from complimentary colours on the spectrum. If you love a picture with a theme, then you will probably love them on nails too. How then can you replicate different aspects within the picture on to the nails themselves and how do the nails you create work together as a set? What parts of the picture could be created in 3D?

One of the great things about Next Top Nail Artist is that the entrants need to create video's showing how they have designed and built the nails so these videos can be really educational for us - the viewer. And as there have been many seasons, the inspiration you can obtain is amazing and ready accessed on You Tube.

So don't be afraid to just get started on your nail competition journey. Even if you don't hand in, your clients will love seeing what you can create with gel and acrylic! And when you have more confidence, then pop in an entry at your next local competition. Or be brave and go for two maybe! Often the entry fees for the categories entered are not expensive. The judges are lovely and have been in your shoes as well as newbies and will help you in your nail competition journey. I promise you will make so many friends and have a positive experience and so much fun too.
